All our prices are flat and net. There are no discounts or "special deals" for big customers or small.

Generally our prices are 10%, 20%, or 30% lower than the prices offered by our competitors even figuring their best discounts, "free" freight, or other gimmicks. Any paperback in print can be ordered in a long-lasting Everbind Edition; a minimum order of 5 copies per title applies in most cases.

All orders of any kind of less than \$25 must be prepaid.

CLASSIC TITLES

Available in Competing Editions from Different Publishers

Some "classic" titles (e.g. *Adventures of Huckleberry Finn*) are in the public domain and are available from several paperback publishers. We offer all the various editions that we can. The text is usually identical, but the page size, type size, margins, and the front and back matter might be different.

Generally, the "trade size" books have bigger pages (5-1/2" x 8-1/2" or larger), with better paper, larger type, wider gutter margins, and more front and back matter. Of course, they usually cost more than mass-size editions of the same title.

The page size of "mass" or "rack"-size books are of uniform size (a little under 4-1/4" x 7"). The nickname "rack-size" comes from the fact that these are the size books one often sees in wire racks in a drugstore.

EXAM COPIES

Can I get a free examination copy of a book?

We are binders, not publishers. Theoretically any well-made Everbind Edition can serve as a sample of the quality of our binding process. Educators can go to the original paperback publisher of a book if they want to examine the content of the book. Nevertheless, we will try to ship an educator the specific title they want to see if we happen to have it in stock. Otherwise, we will send a similar book to show the quality of our binding. WHAT ARE EVERBIND EDITIONS?

Sewn-Bound Hard Cover Books

Everbind re-manufactures publishers' paperback editions into long-lasting hard cover Everbind Editions.

All books are sewn with strong bookbinders thread before being bound into hard covers. A very few titles, less than 1/2 of 1%, listed in on this website catalog are produced by their paperback publishers with so little margin between the type and the binding edge that sewing them would make the type too close to the gutter for easy use. Those titles are done with the finest slow-cure, perfect binding glues on a state-of-the-art perfect binder. The indefinite guarantee applies to the perfect bound Everbind books equally with the sewn bound Everbind books.

All hard cover cases are made of strong plastic-laminate covers that clean with damp cloth over solid binders board.

GUARANTEED

How does Everbind's Unconditional, Indefinite-length Guarantee work?

The binding will not fall apart. The binding will outlast the paper. If the pages are torn out of the book, the Guarantee does not apply. Otherwise the book will be repaired or replaced ... even years from now!

Inspect your books when you receive them. If you are unhappy with them for any reason, call 800-842-4234 for a pick-up and we will issue you a return authorization and pick up the books at our own expense and issue you a credit or refund for your purchase. If you are not dissatisfied with the books, but just change your mind about wanting them, you can still call us, and we will still take them back without question, but you will have to pay for shipping them back.

Do not stamp or mark up the books before you inspect them, or they are not returnable.

Fully processed books are not returnable. You can choose to inspect the books before processing. If you want to inspect your books before returning them to us for processing, there will be no additional charge from us, but you will have to pay for the extra roundtrip shipping costs for the inspection.

PRICE AND AVAILABILITY

Are prices guaranteed?

You'll never have to pay more than you thought you would for a book or book set.

With nearly 20,000 titles from over 100 different publishers represented on this website; and with publishers changing the prices we pay for paperbacks every day, the prices on this website are not guaranteed. We reserve the right to raise prices at any time without notice. If the cost to us of any book or any book in a set is raised, we will raise the price accordingly, but we will always seek your authorization before shipping any books at any price higher than you expected according to your purchase order. Generally, we seek this authorization by faxing or mailing an explanatory form to the billing address.
